CALL FOR LABORATORIES to test Cyanide in a cassava product

The Method Harmonization Working Group of the AOAC Southeast Asia section has recently identified potential discrepancies in test results originating from the use of different analytical test methodologies for total cyanide in cassava products. To confirm potential differences, interested laboratories are invited to participate in a round robin to determine hydrocyanic acid, including hydrocyanic acid bound in cyanogenic glycosides, in a sample processed ready-to-eat cassava chips using the lab's own testing methodology.
